clavus in inner basal angle of corium blackish brown, apex of cuneus infumed; membrane brownish smoky, apex and the large cell whitish hyaline. Under surface of head and thorax and lateral margins and apex of venter blackish; anterior part of pronotum and middle of venter yellowish. Legs pale yellowish or greenish.

Body very gracile, nearly $4 \times$ as long as broad. Hair covering long and pale. Head $0.65-0.72 \times$ as broad as basal width of pronotum; ocular index ♂ 1.11–1.20, ○ 1.50–1.55. Antennae very long and gracile, finely haired; proportions between joints 47:121:7 :52, 1st joint tapering apicad, $1.07-1.12 \times \text{as long as diatone}$, 2nd 1.95 (\circlearrowleft) or 1.73 (\circlearrowleft) × as long as basal width of pronotum. Rostrum long, extending to base of venter. Pronotum 1.5-1.6 × as broad as long in middle, apical margin rugose, callal area globose and glabrous; posterior part of disk convex, transversely wrinkled and rugose. Elytra narrow, nearly 7 × long as broad (width measured at tip of clavus). Propleura rugose. Legs very long and gracile, hind tibia about 2.6 × as long as basal width of pronotum.

Male genitalia in Fig. 41j-s.

Biology: On undergrowth in mountain forests. Host: *Plectranthus fruticosus* (Schuh 1974:41).

Distribution: Widely distributed in tropical Africa. Originally described from Chirinda in S Rhodesia.

Genus Zanchius Distant

Zanchius Distant 1904:477. Type species: Z. annulatus Distant.

Uzeliella Poppius 1911:31. Type species: U. flavovirens Poppius (Carvalho 1952:79).

Poppiella Bergroth 1911:188, new name for Uzeliella Poppius 1911 (nec Uzeliella Baguel 1908, Thysanoptera). Type species: Uzeliella Poppius (Carvalho 1952:79).

Zonodorus Distant 1909b:522. Type species: Z. gubernator Distant (Carvalho 1958:133).

Habrocoris Wagner 1951:153-155. Type species: H. breviceps Wagner (Linnavuori 1964:329).

Diagnosis: Gracile green species. Head short and quadrate; eyes separate from anterolateral corners of pronotum. Pronotum small, lateral and basal margins insinuated, mesoscutum broadly visible. Pygofer conical. Right style small.
